Clerk of Courts Ann Thornburg Weiss

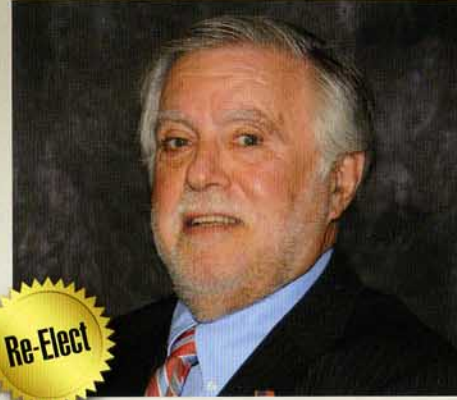

Linda M. Hee for Recorder of Deeds

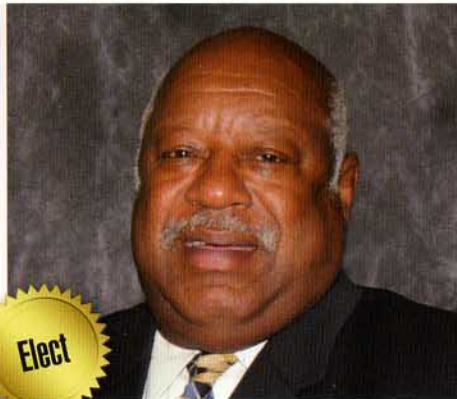
